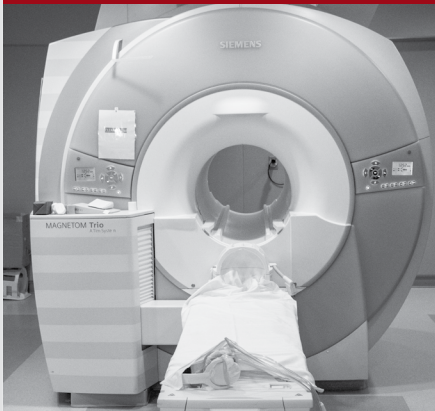


ADVANCED MRI SAFETY TRAINING & ABMRS BOARD PREP
